#### **Performing Flute Choir**

Any student interested in participating in the Performing Flute Choir needs a recommendation from their private flute teacher or band/orchestra director Music for the Finale Concert of the Performing Flute Choir, directed by Phyllis Avidan Louke, will be sent approximately 10 days ahead of time. The music for the select choir is similar to level A music for OMEA contest. Please recommend students who play at this level. The recommending teacher need only sign the participation form on the appropriate line. A limit of 2 recommendations per teacher will be accepted. Only the first 30 applications for the select flute choir will be accepted. Applications received after the 30 Performing Choir slots have been filled are automatically enrolled in the Sight-Reading Choir. No refunds. The sooner the application form is received, the better the chances of participation in the Performing Flute Choir. There is no extra charge for the Performing Flute Choir. Deadline to apply is February 2, 2008.

**Sight-Reading Flute Choir** Any student not interested in the Performing Flute Choir or not recommended by a teacher, will participate in the Sight-Reading Flute Choir directed by GCFS clinicians. Students in the sight-reading choir will be sight-reading music similar to levels C-A of OMEA contest.

### Masterclass

Students interested in performing for Phyllis Avidan Louke in the **masterclass**, <u>must submit an audition tape and \$10</u> <u>application fee no later than February 2</u>, <u>2008</u>. Approximately 3 students will be chosen from the taped audition. Selected students must provide their own pianist.
